Recipe Book

Students are to complete a recipe book containing the following courses and types below in the rubric. The recipe book must be an INDIVIDUAL project. Your recipe book can either be placed in a three prong folder or you can be creative and design it. You will have 13 sections with 2 recipes for each section. You will have a total of 26 recipes in your recipe book. The following should be included on each recipe. Along with your recipes book, you will be required to cook one dish from your recipe book included with a 5 picture documentary. Also listed are the sections that should be included in your recipe book. **This is worth 2 test grades! (One grade for recipe book and one for the dish made)**

➤ Each of your recipes must contain the following:

- Name of the recipe
- Source you got it from(Credit given to Grandma Cooper, Foodnetwork.com, etc)
- All the parts of a recipe (must have yield, time and temperature, container size and type, step by step directions, etc)
- Circle all the cooking terms in the recipe

➤ 5 Picture Documentary Should Include:

- Have someone take pictures of you creating the meal and cleanup.
 - 1 picture showing Prep work
 - 2 pictures showing cooking/ creating the meal
 - 1 picture showing Clean up
 - 1 picture of finished product (Your food)
- Place pictures on Word Document and include captions underneath that explains what you are doing to the Reader
- Print in Black/White or Color
