

**Last Will and Testament
Of
James G. Harseboot**

I, James G. Harseboot, residing at 340 Clintonville Road, Brookfield, Wisconsin 53045, County of Waukesha, State of Wisconsin, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not acting under undue influence of any person, make, publish, and declare this document to be my last will and testament, and expressly revoke any prior wills and codicils, made by me.

**Article I
Payment of Debts, Administration Expenses, and Taxes.**

I direct my personal representative to pay all of my legally enforceable debts, and expenses of my last illness, funeral, burial, and estate administration out of the residue of my estate. I further direct my personal representative to pay out of my residuary estate all estate, income, and inheritance taxes assessed against my taxable estate or the recipient thereof, whether passing by will or by other means, without contribution or reimbursement from any person.

**Article II
Specific Bequest**

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath to Pam Oji all of my percussion instruments, including my drum kit, bongos, and wind chimes, if she shall survive me.

**Article III
Residuary Bequest**

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath to my beloved daughter, Erin Harseboot the rest and remainder of my estate.

**Article IV
Right of Representation**

If my beloved daughter, Erin Harseboot, predeceases me, the interest which would have passed to her had she survived me is hereby given with right of representation to the descendants of said deceased child who survive me. If there is no surviving descendant of said deceased child, my property is hereby given in such shares and to such beneficiaries as would have been the distribution under this will if that child had never lived.

Article V
Personal Representative

I nominate and appoint my daughter, Erin Harseboot, to be personal representative of this will. If Erin Harseboot cannot so act, I appoint Bif Conner as personal representative. No bond shall be required of any personal representative or successor.

Article VI
Survivorship Requirements

If any beneficiary dies prior to the entry of an order, decree, or judgment in my estate, distributing the property in question, or within six months after the date of my death, whichever is earlier, any interest which would have passed to said beneficiary under provisions of the will are to be disposed of according to the plan of distribution which would have been effective under this will if such beneficiary had predeceased me. It is my intention that any property or interest which is distributed from my estate as a result of court order, decree, or judgment will not be revoked or otherwise affected by the subsequent death of the distributee.

I freely and willingly subscribe my name to this will consisting of two pages, including this page, in the presence of these witnesses, each of whom I have requested to subscribe their names in my presence and in the presence of all others.
